Agenda-1: The Compliance of the MoM dated 13.03.2012 regarding listing all the pending cases and providing certificate that all cases worth registration received till 29.02.2012 has been registered.

The Commission took note of the fact that all the receipts till 29.02.2012 worth registration as appeal/complaints have been registered in the Commission and certificate to this effect has been submitted. The commission directed each registry to ensure that henceforth all appeals/complaints worth registration would be registered within the same month.
